

This letter is to request your approval of a telephone conversation between Burton H. Silverstein, d/b/a AAA Assignment Service and F. A. Davis, General Mgr., Koehle Motor Co., Foley Alabama regarding settlement of referenced case No. 8536 $\frac{1}{2}$  judgment against Wesley A. Kilpatrick.
