

Gentlemen:

A garnishment was issued in the above matter directed to you as employer for the defendant on September 1, 1970. An agreement was made with Mrs. Johnson's attorney that she would make certain payments in our office in lieu of you deducting on the garnishment. However, Mrs. Johnson has failed to keep her agreement, and as far as our files reflect Bay Slacks was never released as garnishee in this matter.

At this time we would appreciate you commencing deductions from Mrs. Johnson's salary in order that this account may be liquidated. The amount of the garnishment was \$700, plus court cost. Mrs. Johnson made 2 payments of \$10, each in our office, reducing the garnishment balance by \$20.

If you have any question about this matter please immediately contact my office regarding the deductions.

I would appreciate your reply confirming the fact that you will begin to deduct 25% of Mrs. Johnson's wages.
