



Plaintiff claims of the Defendants, jointly and severally, the sum of TWENTY THOUSAND AND NO/HUNDREDTHS DOLLARS (\$20,000.00) as damages for that heretofore and on, to-wit, December 13, 1968, Plaintiff's minor child, Laura Price, three (3) years of age, was a passenger in a motor vehicle being driven southwardly on U. S. Highway 98, at a point approximately 1.8 miles west of the city limits of Fairhope, Alabama, and at a point where such highway was a public highway in and of the County of Baldwin, State of Alabama, and at such time and place, Defendant Ronald G. Barrett, an agent servant or employee of James E. Barrett, Jr., while in the line and scope of employment as such, who was driving a motor vehicle northwardly on said U. S. Highway 98, so negligently operated such motor vehicle as to cause or allow the same to run into, upon and against the motor vehicle in which Plaintiff's minor child was a passenger. And Plaintiff avers that as a direct and proximate consequence and result of the negligence of Defendant Ronald G. Barrett, an agent, servant or employee of Defendant James E. Barrett, Jr., while acting in the line and scope of employment as such, Plaintiff's minor child suffered a fracture of the right leg; she was broken, bruised and battered and cut about her body; she was caused to be hospitalized for a long period of time; she suffered great pain and mental anguish; and she suffered permanent impairment to her body.

Plaintiff avers that as a further direct and proximate consequence and result of the negligence of the Defendants as aforesaid, Plaintiff as mother of the above named child was

deprived of the service of such child and was caused to incur great expense for the medical care and treatment of such child and will in the future incur further such expense; Plaintiff further expended and will expend great time in the care and nursing of said child, all to her damage as aforesaid.

Wherefore this suit.


COUNT TWO




