Your Petitioner further alleges that upon her return from Florida, that the said Paul and Pauline Rudolph refused to allow her to have her children.

PREMISES CONSIDERED, your Petitioner prays that your Honor will issue a Writ of Habeas Corpus forthwith commanding the said Paul and Pauline Rudolph to have the bodies of the two minor children before this Court at a time and place specified and that your Petitioner be granted the care, custody and control and possession of said minor children pending a hearing of this petition.
