This cause coming on to be heard was submitted upon Bill of Complaint, Decree Pro Confesso on Registered Mail and Testimony as noted by the Register, and upon consideration thereof, the Court is of the opinion that the Complainant is entitled to the relief prayed for in said bill.

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Complainant and Defendant be, and the same are hereby dissolved, and that the said Dorothy L. Andrews is forever divorced from the said Henry E. Andrews for and on account of Abandonment.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED ADJUDGED AND DECREED That the Complainant, Dorothy L. Andrews, shall have the care, custody and control of the minor children, Ann Andrews, age about 9 years, and Bonnie Andrews, age about 7 years.

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that neither party to this suit shall again marry except to each other until sixty days after the rendition of this decree, and that if appeal is taken within sixty days, neither party shall again marry except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.

It is further ordered that the Complainant and Respondent be, and they are hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon payment of the cost of this suit.

It is further ordered that Dorothy L. Andrews the Complainant pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which executed may issue.

That my name is Dorothy L. Andrews, I am over the age of 21 and a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama and have been more than two years next preceeding. The Respondent Henry E. Andrews is over the age of 21 and is presently a non-resident of the State of Alabama. We were married on November 25, 1939 and lived together as husband and wife in Alabama since that time until our separation on or about May 18, 1954, the respondent having abandoned me and gone some where in Florida. I know of no cause on my part for the abandonment. He left on or about May 18, 1954 and we have not lived together as husband and wife since that date. There were born as fruits of this marriage two children, Ann Andrews, age 9, and Bonnie Andrews, age 7. I have had the care, custody and control of these two children since birth and I respectfully represent to this Honorable Court that I am a fit, suitable and proper person to have their permanent care, custody and control. I do not ask for support for them at this time because the respondent is outside the jurisdiction of this court. I know that we will never live together again as husband and wife and respectfully ask that I be granted a divorce and the custody of my children.

That my name is Vera Chastang, I know both parties to this cause, they are both over the age of 21 and resided in Baldwin County, Alabama at the time of their marriage on November 25, 1939 when they married at Bay Minette. The Respondent Henry E. Andrews abandoned the complainant Dorothy L. Andrews about May 18, 1954 and they have not lived together since then as husband and wife. There was born as fruits of this marriage two children Ann Andrews, age 9, and Bonnie Andrews, age 7. I respectfully recommend the Complainant to be a fit, suitable and proper person to have the care, custody and control of these two children, I do not believe the parties to this cause will ever live together again as husband and wife.

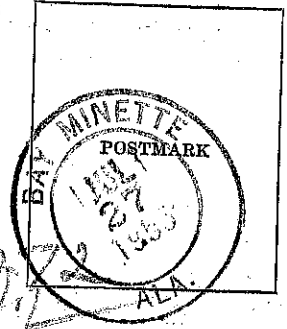

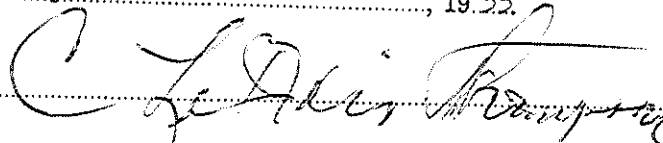

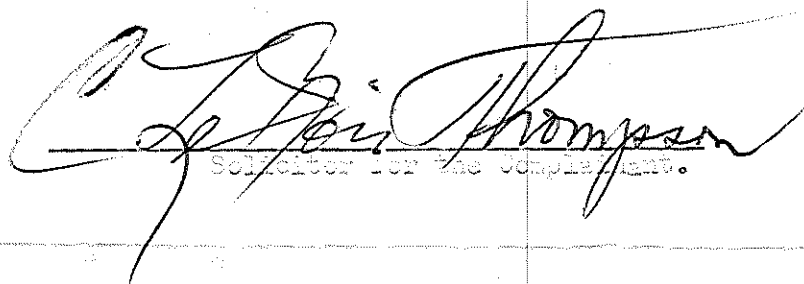
That on May 18, 1954, while your Complainant and Respondent were
