years. I respectfully represent to this Honorable Court that I am a fit  
suitable and proper person to have the care custody and control of this child  
as I have had her care custody and control since birth. The Respondent  
Isham Locke has not supported our child although he takes from \$50.00 to  
\$60.00 a week and while I do not ask for support for myself I respectfully  
ask for maintenance and support for the child and feel that the said respondent  
should provide at least \$20.00 a month for the child as support.

That my name is Estella Padgett, I know both parties to this cause, they  
are both over the age of 21 and have been residents of Alabama for more than





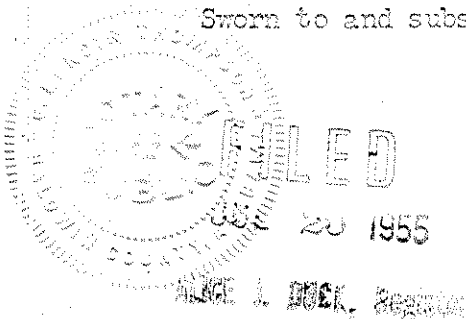
