1.

That your Complainant is a bond fide resident citizen of Baldwin County, Alabama, and has been for two years next preceding the filing of this bill of Complaint, and over twenty-one years of age; that the Respondent is over twenty-one years of age, and a resident of Ensley, Jefferson County, Alabama.

That your Complainant and the Respondent married at Birmingham, Alabama, on to-wit, January 20, 1941, and lived together as husband and wife until on to-wit, September 20, 1946.

That on to-wit, September 20, 1946, the Respondent voluntarily abandoned the bed and board of your Complainant and has remained away voluntarily and continuously since that time.

There has been no children born to this union; the Complainant and the Respondent own no joint property to be divided in this proceeding.

WHEREFORE, the premises considered, Your Complainant prays that Your Honor will by proper process make the said Ella Bolar party Respondent to this Bill of Complaint requiring her to plead, answer or demur to the same within the time and under the penalties prescribed by law and the practice of this Honorable Court.

Your Complainant further prays that upon a final hearing hereof, Your Honor will enter a decree forever barring the bonds of matrimony existing between your Complainant and the Respondent; Your Complainant prays for such other, further, different or general relief as she may be in equity and good conscience entitled to receive.
