After discussing this matter with us and the gentlemen that were with Mr. Knight on the boat when he drowned, what is your opinion as to this offer to settle any claim which the Minor, Barbara Jane Knight has against Mr. Knight's Employer, Western Geophysical Company? Do you think the \$4,000.00 would be for the best interest of this child?
- A. I think it would be.

ON CROSS EXAMINATION OF THIS WITNESS BY MR. SWEARINGEN, HE TESTIFIED:

- Q. Would this minor get the sum total of \$4,000.00, or would there be court costs, etc. here and in New Orleans deducted from that sum?
- MR. OWEN: I think I could answert at better. There would be no Court cost deduced from the minor's stand-point either here or New O rleans. There will be some Attorneys' fees deducted.
- Q. The Attorneys' fee would be deducted from the \$4,000.00?

 MR. OWENS: Yes.
- Q. Do you think that the \$4,000.00 lumb sum would probably be a better settlement than a continuing some over a period of time?
- A. At the present time I believe it would, because they don't need the money at the present time, and it would be drawing interest, and probably for three or four years they won't need it.

get, that is, relative to Mr. Knight's death, do you think that the \$4,000.00 settlement would be preferable to a suit in New Orleans? Do you think the testimony would be too adverse for a suit for a larger sum to be warranted?
