DECREE REMOVING DISABILITIES
OF NON-AGE OF GEORGE EUGENE DANA, A MINOR

This cause coming on to be heard upon the verified petition of Clarice G. Dana as mother of George Eugene Dana for the removal of disabilities of non-age of the said George Eugene Dana, this being the day set to hear and determine said petition.

Now comes the Petitioner, and the testimony of the witnesses have been taken by an Affidavit, pursuant to the direction of the Court, and the Court finding that the facts stated in the said Petition are true; that the said Clarice G. Dana resides in the City of Fairhope, Baldwin County, Alabama; and the said George Eugene Dana resides with the Petitioner; that the father of the said George Eugene Dana is dead and that he, the said George Eugene Dana, is over the age of eighteen years and will reach his 21st birthday on, to-wit, the 25th of May, 1957; and the Court Being satisfied that it will be to the best interest of said minor to be relieved of the disability of non-age, and that a copy of said petition and the decree or order of this Court having been served by the sheriff of Baldwin County, Alabama upon the said minor, George Eugene Dana, personally, and that no objections being filed to the granting of said petition, it is, therefore

CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED, that the prayer of said Petitioner be and hereby is granted, that it will be to the interest of the said minor, George Eugene Dana, to be relieved of the disability of non-age unconditionally and without restrictions.

It is, therefore, considered, ordered, adjudged and decreed that the said George Eugene Dana be and hereby is relieved of the disabilities of non-age unconditionally and without restrictions and that he be and hereby is invested with the right to sue and be sued, contract, buy, sell and convey real estate and generally to do and perform all actions which he could lawfully do if twenty-one years of age; that a duly certified copy of this decree be filed for record in the office of the Judge of Probate of Baldwin County, Alabama; that the Petitioner pay the costs in this behalf incurred.
