Now comes the Complainant, J. E. Still, doing business as
Still Motor Company, and files this bill to foreclose a mechanic
and materialman lien, and shows unto your Honor and unto this

I

That your Complainant is over the age of 21 years and a
resident of Baldwin County, Alabama; that the permanent residence
of the Respondent is unknown to the Complainant but the Respondent's

PRAYER FOR PROCESS

The premises considered, your Complainant prays that O. B. Williams be made a party Respondent hereto by the usual process of this court commanding the Respondent to plead, answer or demur to within the time and in the manner provided by law and the rules of this Court, or failing therein, that a decree pro confesso be entered against said Respondent.

PRAYER FOR RELIEF


