It is further ordered that OLGA SCHOBER QUINLAN-----the COMPLAINANT-----pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which executed may issue.

BILL OF COMPLAINT

Your complainant, OLGA SCHOBBER QUINLAN, represents and shows unto your Honor as follows:

1. That she is over the age of twenty-one and is a bona-fide resident of Baldwin County, State of Alabama, and has been for 1 year next preceeding filing of this suit.
2. That NICHOLAS J. QUINLAN is over the age of twenty-one and is a resident of New York City, New York.
3. That your complainant and respondent were lawfully married in New York City, New York, the 10th day of June, 1946.
4. Complainant further avers that said respondent voluntarily abandoned the bed and board of complainant for more than one year next preceding the filing of this Bill of Complaint, since which time complainant and respondent have not lived together as man and wife. Respondent has refused to return to complainant or to allow complainant to live with him.

The premises considered, your complainant prays that NICHOLAS J. QUINLAN be made a party respondent to this Bill of Complaint, that he be required to plead, answer, or demur within the time required by law; and that upon a final hearing of this cause your Honor will enter a decree forever divorcing complainant and respondent, granting complainant the right to remarry, and that your Honor will grant such other, further, different, and general relief to which complainant may be in equity and good conscience, entitled.
