



COUNT ONE

Plaintiff claims of the Defendant the sum of TEN THOUSAND (\$10,000.00) DOLLARS as damages, for that heretofore and on, to-wit: the 8th day of October, 1968, the Defendant so negligently operated a motor vehicle along or upon Highway No. U.S. 98 at a point thereon 2.8 miles South of the Daphne, Alabama city limits which was then a public highway in Baldwin County, Alabama, as to run into, upon or against the motor vehicle in which the Plaintiff was riding, ^{as a passenger} and thereby and as the proximate result and consequence thereof, the Plaintiff received severe personal injuries in this, to-wit: she suffered a severe injury to her neck; she was bruised; she was made sick, sore and lame; and she was permanently injured; she was caused to expend considerable sums for medical treatment, physical therapy, doctor bills and medicines in and about the treatment of her injuries; she suffered and continues to suffer great mental anguish and physical pain, all for which she claims damages as aforesaid.

Plaintiff avers that she received said injuries as aforesaid, as the proximate result and consequence from the negligence of the Defendant, hence this suit.
