The Plaintiff further avers that the Defendant agreed in the promissory note to pay all expenses including reasonable attorney's fees incurred in the collecting same and the Plaintiff claims a reasonable attorney's fee in the amount of \$10.00. The Plaintiff aversthat the Defendant waived all right of exemption under the laws of the State of Alabama as to personal property.




