The Plaintiff avers that the Defendant defaulted in the payments and under the provisions of the note sued on, the whole balance became due and payable. The Plaintiff further avers that the Defendant agreed in the promissory note to pay all expenses including reasonable attorney's fees incurred in the collecting same and the Plaintiff claims a reasonable attorney's fee in the amount of \$25.00. The Plaintiff avers that the Defendant waived all right of exemption under the laws of the State of Alabama as to personal property.

The Plaintiff claims of the Defendant the sum of SIXTY EIGHT and 91/100 DOLLARS (\$68.91), balance due after all proper credits given on a promissory note made by the Defendant on the 28th day of October, 1968 and payable as follows: A \$5.00 payment every other Friday until the principal has been paid. The first payment due November 8, 1968. The Plaintiff avers that the Defendant defaulted in the payments and under the provisions of the note sued on, the whole balance became due and payable. The Plaintiff further avers that the Defendant agreed in the promissory note to pay all expenses including reasonable attorney's fees incurred in the collecting same and the Plaintiff claims a reasonable attorney's fee in the amount of \$10.00. The Plaintiff aversthat the Defendant waived all right of exemption under the laws of the State of Alabama as to personal property.

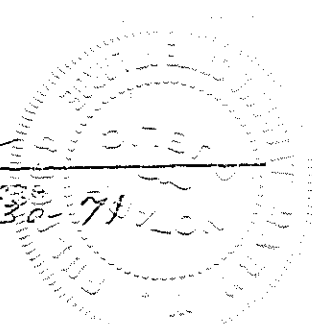
