COUNT ONE

The Plaintiff claims of the Defendants Two Thousand Six Hundred Forty-two and 82/100ths Dollars (\$2,642.82), due by promissory note made by them on the twentieth day of February, 1967, and payable on the first day of July, 1967, together with interest thereon from maturity at a rate of six percent (6%) per annum.

The Plaintiff further alleges that in and by the terms of said note the Defendants agreed to pay all costs of collecting or securing, or attempting to collect or secure, said note, including a reasonable attorney's fee, and the Plaintiff claims of the

Defendants the further and additional sum of Five Hundred Twenty-five Dollars (\$525.00) as such reasonable attorney's fee.

The Plaintiff further alleges that in and by the terms of said note the Defendants waived as to the debt evidenced thereby all right of exemption under the Constitution and Laws of Alabama, or any other state, and the Plaintiff claims the benefit of said waiver.
