


Your Oratrix Missouri Boykin, respectfully represents and shows unto your Honor and unto the Court:

First. First.

That she is over the age of Twenty-one years and has been a bona fide resident citizen of the County of Baldwin and State of Alabama for a period of more than three years.

That Jasper Boykin is over the age of Twenty-one years and reside at Pensacola, Florida, County of Escambia.

Second.
