I am the complainant in the suit to quiet title pending in the Circuit Court of Baldwin County, Alabama, in equity, against Robert Bittner, Carrie Bittner, John Stelk, Trustee, Chicago Title and Trust Company, Carrie B. Tuttle and Wm. H. Tuttle and the East half of the Northeast quarter of the Northeast quarter and the West half of the Northeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 16, Township 8 South, Range 4 East, Baldwin County. The said named individual defendants are non-residents of the State of Alabama and each of them are over the age of 21 years, and their Post Office addresses and places of residence are unknown. The Chicago Title and Trust Company is a corporation, in Chicago, whose address is unknown. I have made and caused to be made diligent search and inquiry to ascertain the places of residence and addresses of each of them, if they are still living, and the names of their heirs if dead and have been unable to ascertain the same. They are said to claim some right, title, interest in, claim or encumbrances upon the lands described above. The title to the said lands stands on the records of Baldwin County in my name. Tuttle, July 8, 1931, who acquired the title by mesne conveyances from the United States Government. 

Tuttle, if living, are over the ages of twenty-one years and non-residents of the State of Alabama, and if dead, their unknown heirs, devisees, personal representatives, alienees, successors in trust, beneficiaries and assigns are over the age of twenty-one years and are non-residents of the State of Alabama, their places of residence and post office addresses being unknown, that the said Robert Bittner, Clara Bittner, John Stelk, Trustee, Chicago Title and Trust Company, a Corporation, Carrie B. Tuttle and William H. Tuttle, if living, claim or are reputed to claim and if dead, their unknown heirs, devisees, personal representatives alienees, successors in trust, beneficiaries and assigns, claim

or are reputed to claim some title to, interest in, claim, lien or encumbrance upon the East half of the Northeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 16, Township 8 South, Range 4 East, and the West half of the Northeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 16, Township 8 South, Range 4 East, all in Baldwin County, Alabama, or some part of parcel thereof.

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed that notice of the pendency of said suit be given by publication once a week for four weeks consecutively in the Baldwin Times, a newspaper, published in Bay Minette, in Baldwin County, Alabama.







This cause coming on to be heard is submitted for final decree upon behalf of the Complainant, upon the original bill of complaint and upon the service, pleading and proof as noted by the Register; and the same being considered by the Court, the Court is of the opinion, does find, ascertain and decree, that due and proper notice of the pendency of the said bill of complaint against the said lands and the named defendants, Robert Bittner, Clara Bittner, John Stelk, Trustee, Chicago Title and Trust Co., a Corporation, and Carrie B. Tuttle, and William H. Tuttle, and the unknown heirs, devisees, personal representatives, alienees, successors in trust, beneficiaries and assigns of the said named corporation, individuals and each of them and any and all persons, firms, associations, corporations, claiming any title to, interest in, claim, lien or encumbrance on said lands or any part thereof, has been given in the manner required by law, and that the Complainant is entitled to the relief as prayed for in his bill of complaint.

IT IS THEREFORE FOUND, ASCERTAINED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court that the said Complainant, Claude Peteet, is over the age of twenty-one years and a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama; that at the time of the filing of the said bill of complaint and at the time of the submission of this cause for final decree, the complainant was and is in the actual and peaceable possession, claiming to own the same absolutely, and in fee simple of all that certain land situated in the County of Baldwin, State of Alabama, described as follows, to-wit:

East half of the Northeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 16, Township 8 South, Range 4 East, and the West half of the Northeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 16, Township 8 South, Range 4 East, all in Baldwin County, Alabama;

That the Complainant obtained title to the said lands as follows: The East half of the Northeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 16, Township 8 South, Range 4 East, by deed recorded in the office of the Judge of Probate in Deed Book 67, page 561, from the State of Alabama, who acquired the same May 30, 1927, by sale for Taxes, assessed to Robert Bittner and Clara Bittner, who acquired the same from Ernest Duesterberg, July 17, 1923, by deed recorded in said Probate office in Deed Book 33 NS, page 390, who acquired the same by mesne conveyances from the United States Government; that the Complainant obtained title to the said lands as follows: West half of the Northeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 16, Township 8 South, Range 4 East, from G. C. Prewett and Maude Prewett, his wife, January 2, 1945, by deed recorded in the office of the Judge of Probate of Baldwin County, Alabama, in Deed Book 87 NS, page 381, who acquired the same March 1, 1934, by deed recorded in said office in Deed Book 67 NS, pages 217-8, under foreclosure of mortgage from J. H. Lassetter dated June 10, 1942, recorded in said office in Mortgage Book 92, pages 313-14 to G. W. Hanna, the said mortgage having been by the said G. W. Hanna transferred to the said G. C. Prewett by instrument dated June 10, 1942, recorded in said office in Mort-

gage Book 92, at page 314, the said J. H. Lassetter having acquired the same from G. W. Hanna by deed dated June 10, 1942, recorded in the said office in Deed Book 77 NS, at page 386, who acquired the same by tax deed from the State of Alabama dated May 9, 1935, recorded in said office in Deed Book 59, NS, at page 551, who acquired the same July 8, 1931, by tax sale under an assessment to W. H. Tuttle, who acquired the same by mesne conveyances from the United States; that the title to the said lands and each parcel thereof stand in the name of the Complainant upon the records of Baldwin County, Alabama; that for more than ten years next preceding the filing of said bill of complaint no person other than those through whom he claims title to the said lands or any part thereof have assessed or paid taxes thereon.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the said Claude Peteet at the time of the filing of the Bill of Complaint in this cause and at this time had and has the fee simple title to the above described lands, and to each and every part and parcel thereto, that neither of the said defendants, Robert Bittner, Clara Bittner, John Stelk, Trustee, Chicago Title and Trust Co., a Corporation, Carrie B. Tuttle and William H. Tuttle and the unknown heirs, devisees, personal representatives, alienees, successors in trust, beneficiaries and assigns of the said named corporation, individuals and each of them and any and all persons, firms, associations, corporations, have any title to, interest in, claim, lien or encumbrance upon the whole or any part of the said lands, and that the fee simple title to the said lands and each and every part and parcel thereof be and the same is hereby quieted and established in and declared to be in the said Claude Peteet, as against the defendants, Robert Bittner, Clara Bittner, John Stelk, Trustee, Chicago Title and Trust Co., a Corporation, Carrie B. Tuttle and William H. Tuttle, and the unknown heirs, devisees, personal representatives, alienees, successor in trust, beneficiaries and assigns of the said named corporation, individuals and each of them and any and all persons, firms, associations, corporations claiming any title to, interest in, claim

lien or encumbrance on said lands or any part thereof.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the title hereby quieted and established in and declared to be in the said Claude Peteet, shall inure to the benefit of all persons deriving title to said lands or any part therein, from or through the said Claude Peteet, and the said title so quieted and established in him shall be treated and considered as established in favor of the said Claude Peteet and all persons deriving title through him.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that a certified copy of this decree be, by the Register of this Court, recorded in the office of the Judge of Probate of Baldwin County, Alabama, in which County the said land lies, within thirty days from the date of this decree, and that the cost thereof be taxed as a part of the cost in this proceeding.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the said Claude Peteet be and he is hereby taxed with the cost of this proceeding for which let execution issue.
