child, CHARLES STEPHEN DUCK, now nineteen months old; that said child is now and has been all of his life with your Complainant; that she is the suitable, fit and proper person to have his care, custody and control.

That the Respondent is an able bodied man and fully capable of supporting the child.

WHEREFORE the premises considered your Complainant prays that your Honor will, by proper process make the said Charles Linberg Duck, party respondent to this bill of complaint, requiring him to plead, answer or demur to the same within time and under the penalties prescribed by law, and the practice of this Honorable Court;

Complainant further prays that your Honor will upon a final hearing hereof, award to her a decree of divorce forever barring the bonds of matrimony existing between your Complainant and the Respondent; that your Honor will award to her such amount as may seem proper, as permanent alimony to be paid by the Respondent to her toward the maintenance and support of the minor child, Charles Stephen Duck; that she be awarded the custody, care and control of said child; that she be granted such other, further, difference or general relief as she may be in equity and good conscience entitled to receive.
