My name is Anna Bucek. I am a bona fide resident of Baldwin County, Alabama, and over twenty-one years of age. The Respondent Joseph Bucek is over twenty-one years of age.

The Respondent and I married at Robertsdale in Baldwin County, Alabama on March 25th, 1933.

I am now sixty-one years of age and the Respondent is now sixty years of age.

The Respondent and I for some years have not been able to get along. It has been an almost continuous fussing between us.

The Respondent has on several occasions committed actual violence to my person by striking me, which necessarily endangered my life and health.

Conditions grew worst from time to time until about August 15, I concluded that I could no longer live with him, as I felt that his demeanor and conduct towards me was seriously hampering my help. I have grown more nervous from time to time until I have finally concluded that it is absolutely impossible for me to live with him as his wife.

We have no children and there are no properties involved as between us.

Anna Bucek

My name is James Sanca. I live at Robertsdale, in Baldwin County, Alabama, about a mile from where Mr. and Mrs. Ducek live. I have known them for the past 16 years.

I have had occasion to see and talk with them very often. I know that for the past several years its been an almost continuous fussing between them. I know from my own personal observation that conditions are such that they cannot live together as husband and wife.

They are both in their sixtys and highly nervous and their conduct toward each other in my opinion is seriously hampering their help. I have concluded, having had the opportunity to see and be around them, that it is to the best interest of both that they separate. While I have never seen Mr. Ducek strike Mrs. Ducek, she has often complained to me, as well as to other as to his conduct toward her.
