It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Complainant and Defendant be, and the same are hereby, dissolved, and that the said Annie Mae Green is forever divorced from the said Cedric Green for and on account of

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED, by the court, that the Respondent be, and he is hereby awarded the custody, care and control of the minor child, Charles Cedric Green, with the right of the Complainant to visit him at reasonable times.

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that neither party to this suit shall again marry except to each other until sixty days after the rendition of this decree, and that if appeal is taken within sixty days, neither party shall again marry except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.

It is further ordered that the Complainant and Respondent be, and they are hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon the payment of the cost of this suit.

It is further ordered that Cedric Green

the Respondent pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which execution may issue.

have called and caused to come before me H. M. Hallwitness named in the Requirement for Oral Examination, on the 20 day of October 1949, at the office of H. M. Hallin Bay Minette, Alabama, and having first sworn said Witness to speak the truth, the whole truth, and nothing but the truth, the said Annie Mae Green doth depose and say as follows:

My name is Annie Mae Green. I am a bona fide resident of Bay Minette, Baldwin County, Alabama, and twenty years old; the Respondent Cedric Green, is a bona fide resident of Bay Minette, Baldwin County, Alabama, and twenty-three years of age;

The Respondent and I married at Bay Minette, Alabama, on August 15, 1944. We lived together as husband and wife until August 19, 1949.

The Respondent on and prior to August 19, 1949, often threatened and abused me and on several occasions did actual violence to my person by striking me. His conduct toward me was such as to given me every reasonable apprehension to believe and I did actually believe that if I continued to livewith him, he would carry out his threats and do further violence to my person which would necessarily endanger my life and health.

I have on three occasions prior to August 19, 1949, on account of the cruel treatment on the part of the Respondent had to leave him, however, each time decided to go back in an effort to make a go of it, however, each time have failed. I know from past experiences that it is absolutely impossible for me to live with the Respondent. I cannot any longer put up with or endure his cruel treatment of me, and his threats toward me.

We have one child, Charles Cedric Green, who is now four years old and is living with me.

I am now, as I have each time the Respondent forced me to leave him, living with my father and mother. They are perfectly agreeable that my child and I live in the home with them.

My sister Sarah Nell Skipper has a number of time heard the Respondent threaten me and has seen him commit actual violence on my person. There are several other persons that have also heard him threaten me and seen him strike me. I am absolutely positive that I cannot live with the Respondent any longer.

Annie Mae Green

My name is Sarah Nell Skipper. I am a sister of the Complainant Annie Mae Green. My sister and the Respondent have been living near us and I have had an occasion to be with and see them during the time they have been married.

I know that the Respondent has often threatened my sister, and that on different occasions he has committed actual violence to her person by striking her. My sister and the Respondent on account of the mistreatment of my sister on the part of the Respondent have separated on three occasions prior to the last time, and eachtime my sister has returned to live with him in an effort to get along. I know that the Complainant and the Respondent cannot get along.

That your Complainant and the Respondent married at Bay Minette, Alabama, on August 15th, 1944, and lived together as husband and wife, until August 19th, 1949, when for the reason hereinafter set out, your Complainant was forced to abandone living with the Respondent.

That on August 19, 1949, and on various occasions prior thereto, the Respondent threatened and abused your Complainant and did actual violence to her person by striking her, which necessarily endangered her

life and health; that the conduct of the Respondent was to given your Complainant every reasonable apprehension to believe and she did actually believe that if she continued to live with the Respondent he would carry out his threats, which would necessarily endanger her life and health.

4.

That there was born to the marriage between your Complainant and the Respondent, one child, Charles Cedric Green, now four years old; that your Complainant is the suitable, fit and proper person to have the care custody and control of said child.

WHEREFORE the premises considered your Complainant prays that your Honor will by proper process make the said Cedric Green, party respondent to this bill of complaint, requiring him to plead, answer or demur to the same within the time and under the penalties prescribed by law, and the practice of this Honorable Court.

Complainant further prays that your Honor will upon a final hearing hereof, award to her a decree of divorce forever barring the bonds of matrimony existing between your Complainant and the Respondent; that she be awarded the custody, care and control of the minor child, Charles Cedric Green; that she be granted such other, further, different or general relief as she may be in equity and good conscience entitled to receive.
