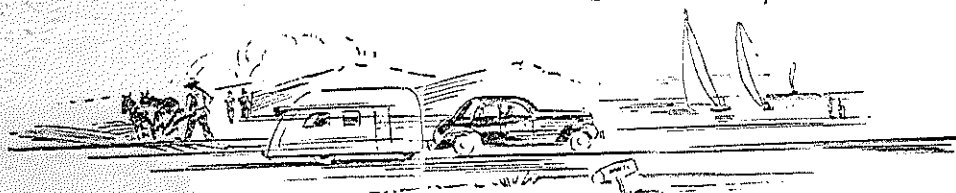

Mrs. Vivian L. McGill, having been
first duly and legally sworn, testified
as follows:

ON EXAMINATION

By Mr. McMurphy

Q. Are you Mrs. Vivian L. McGill?

A. I am.

Q. Are you over the age of twenty-one years and a resident of
Baldwin County, Alabama?

A. I am.

Q. Were you heretofore appointed and qualified as guardian of John
Hamilton McGill, a non compos mentis?

A. I was.

Q. Was the administration of that estate removed from the Probate
Court of Baldwin County, Alabama to the Circuit Court of Baldwin
County, Alabama, Equity side on September 30, 1949?

A. Yes.

Q. Are you now acting as guardian of John Hamilton McGill, a non
compos mentis?

A. Yes.

Q. Since your appointment as such guardian have you handled all of
the affairs of this estate to the best of your ability?

A. I have.

Q. Have you not used any of the funds or other assets of the estate for your own benefit either directly or indirectly as provided by law?

A. No.

Q. Have all of the assets belonging to this estate been spent by you for the support and maintenance of the family of John Hamilton McGill?

A. They have.

Q. I will show you an accounting filed by you in this case and ask if this correctly represents the amount of money you have received and have spent as such guardian with the addition of one hundred dollars not shown with with you charge yourself accountable?

A. Yes.

Q. Is it true that all the expenditures as shown by this accounting was spent by you for the support and maintenance of the family of John Hamilton McGill?

A. They have.

Q. I will ask you particularly about one item listed in September 1946 as an automobile four hundred and ninety-five dollars, did you at that time buy an automobile for that price?

A. I did.

Q. Was the amount of money paid for the automobile a reasonable price?

A. I think so.

Q. Was there any particular reason why you needed an automobile at that time?

A. I did. I needed it to go home at night from my work.

Q. Do you work at night?

A. Yes.

Q. What time do you get off?

A. Nine-thirty to ten o'clock.

Q. How far do you live from your place of work?

A. Eight blocks.

ON EXAMINATION

By Mr. Beebe, Guardian Ad Litem

Q. Mrs. McGill, did you use the automobile in taking the children to and from school?

A. No. They live just across the street from school. I used it to go back and forth to work.

Q. Your guardianship extended over a period of how many years?

A. Three.

Q. Mrs. McGill, in September, 1946, you list as sale of real property eleven hundred dollars, that real property of course belonged to John Hamilton McGill?

A. Yes.

Q. You sold it under order of court?

A. Yes sir.

Q. This thirteen hundred dollars under order of the Probate Court?

A. Yes sir.

Q. Was that all you received for the sale of those properties?

A. Yes, with that one hundred dollars additional.

Q. These items listed here as expenditures running anywhere from ninety dollars to one hundred and eighty dollars, some of it would be maintenance, - what were those listed as, support and maintenance?

A. Well, just living expenses, groceries, lights, water, gas, school books and things.

Q. How many children do you have?

A. I have four at home.

Q. You supported four children with these monthly expenditures?

A. Yes I did.

Q. During that period did you work yourself?

A. Yes.

Q. Did you use your funds to supplement your living expenses?

A. I certainly did.

Q. Do you mind stating how much you make?

A. Not at all. It's fourteen dollars and twenty cents a week after social security is taken out.

THE COURT: Has the Veterans Administration been given the proper notice?

COUNSEL: Yes.
