We had gotten along fairly well and would have continued to live together but for the frictions between my husband and one of my children by a former marriage, which brought about an estrangement between us and as a result he and I ceased living together as husband and wife sometime in the early part of October of last year, and this abandonment has continued since that date with no resumption of marital relations. We have both concluded that it is best for his family and mine, as well as for us, that our marriage be dissolved. Since our separation, I lived with my children in Fairhope for a while but later left to obtain work in St. Louis, where I am now employed, but expect to return to Fairhope in the fairly near future.
