It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Complainant and Defendant be, and the same are hereby, dissolved, and that the said Mary Green is forever divorced from the said Hubert Clifton Green Jr. for and on account of Cruelty

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that neither party to this suit shall again marry except to each other until sixty days after the rendition of this decree, and that if appeal is taken within sixty days, neither party shall again marry except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.

It is further ordered that the Complainant and Respondent be, and they are hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon the payment of the cost of this suit.

It is further ordered that Mary Green the Complainant pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which execution may issue.

Grimes Jr. doth depose and say as follows:

My name is Mary Green. I am over twenty-one years of age and a resident of the State of Alabama and have been all of my life.

The Respondent, Hubert Clifton Green, Jr., is over twenty-one years of age and a bona fide resident of the State of Alabama.

The Respondent and I married at Summerdale in Baldwin County, Alabama, on September 2, 1949. We lived together as husband and wife until on to-wit, April 1, 1950.

The Respondent on and prior to April 1, 1950, threatened and abused me and threatened to do actual violence to my person which would necessarily endanger my life and health. The conduct of the Respondent was such as to give me every reasonable apprehension to believe and I did actually believe that if I continued to live with him he would carry out his threats and do violence to my person, which would necessarily endanger my life and health.

The Respondent and I have no children and no community property.

I am personally acquainted with the Complainant and the Respondent in this cause. I have had occasion to be around them from time to time while they lived together as husband and wife. I know, from my own observation, that it was impossible for the Complainant and the Respondent to live together as husband and wife.

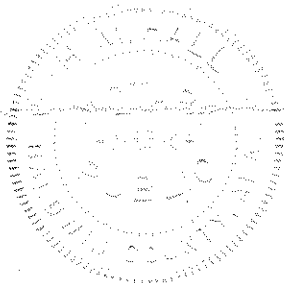

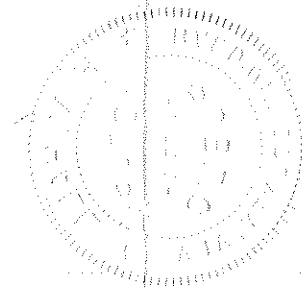

2.


That your Complainant and the Respondent married at Summerdale,
