Bryant or Mrs. Claire Bryant for the erection of a frame structure on Lot No. 4 in Hand Brothers subdivision to the Town of Bay Minette, Alabama, said Respondents demur and assign the following separate and several grounds, viz:
- (a) That it is not stated when such information was obtained. (b) That it is not shown that such permit was not obtained before the filing of said Bill of Complaint. (c) That it is not alleged that such building permit was not issued before construction was started on such building..
