I am 52 years old and my husband, Carlos C. Mixson, is 43. We were married July 15th 1938 in Mobile, Alabama. We lived as husband and wife from that date in Baldwin County, Alabama, not far from Barnwell. I still live at that same place. On August 31st 1950, my husband gave me a brutal beating. He used his fists and then a large metal flash light. He bruised me badly all over my face and body and he broke two ribs. This is not the first time that he has mistreated me but it was the worst. He has left me, from time to time, and then he would come back and ask that I take him in. This I did twice, hoping that he might mend his ways. It seems that something of the devil has gotten into him. I am deathly afraid of him. He has threatened to kill me and I believe that he might do that if there should be another time. We have no children nor property. He has never decently provided for me and I want nothing from him but to be free of the mess he has created in my life.

And the said Dr. C. G. Godard doth depose and say as follows:

I am a physician licensed under the State of Alabama and maintain an office in Fairhope, Alabama. Mrs. Mixson was in my office the morning of September 1st 1950. I treated her for very severe bruises and scratches. She had a bad cut on the back of her head and at least two of her ribs were fractured. She must have been beaten up brutally to have been in as bad a way as was apparent.



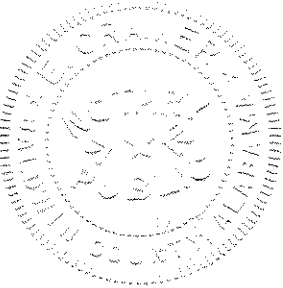

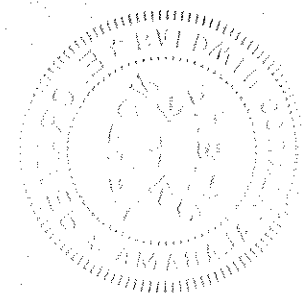

To the Honorable Telfair J. Mashburn, Jr., Judge of said Court, sitting
in Equity:

Comes Ola Lee Mixson and exhibits this, her Bill of Complaint against
Carlos C. Mixson and shows unto Your Honor as follows:

First: Complainant, whose age is 52 years, and Respondent, Carlos C.
Mixson, whose age is 43 years, intermarried July 15th 1938 in Mobile,
Alabama, and both parties have been residents of Baldwin County, Alabama,
since said marriage, having lived together as husband and wife until
August 31st 1950 at which time, because of the acts hereinafter complained
of, they separated.

Second: On August 31st 1950, and at previous times, Respondent did commit
acts of physical violence upon the person of Complainant, breaking several
of her ribs and bruising her severely otherwise, and, from his conduct,
there is reasonable apprehension that he might continue to treat Complainant
in a similar manner so as to put her in fear of her life, limb and health.

The premises considered, Complainant prays that said Carlos C. Mixson be
made party Defendant hereto by all due and appropriate legal process and
that he be compelled to plead, answer ~~or~~ demur to the within Bill of Com-
plaint within the time prescribed by law and the practices of Your Honor-
able Court and that he be compelled to abide and obey all orders and decrees
made in the premises.

Further, Complainant prays, upon a hearing of the within cause, that a
decree be ordered and entered forever divorcing her from said Carlos C.
Mixson and granting her such other, further and different relief as, to
Your Honor, may seem meet and proper.
