This cause coming on to be heard on this date is submitted on behalf of the Complainant upon the original Bill of Complaint, Answer of the Respondent and the Testimony as noted by the Register, upon consideration of all of which the Court is of the opinion that the Complainant is entitled to the relief prayed for by her in her said Bill of Complaint, WHEREUPON, it is therefore Ordered, Adjudged and Decreed by the Court as follows:
