

In the Matter of the Removal of the Disabilities of Non-Age of E. F. Stuart, Jr. In the Circuit Court of Baldwin County, Alabama In Equity.

TO THE HONORABLE CIRCUIT COURT OF BALDWIN COUNTY, ALABAMA, IN EQUITY, AND TO THE HONORABLE TELFAIR J. MASHBURN, JR., JUDGE THEREOF:

Comes your Petitioner, the undersigned Amanda Lou Stuart, and respectfully represents and shows unto your Honor and unto this Honorable Court as follows:

FIRST:

That she is over the age of twenty-one years and a resident citizen of Baldwin County, Alabama.

SECOND:

That she is the mother of E. F. Stuart, Jr., a minor over the age of eighteen years and under the age of twenty-one years and that the said monor resides with your Petitioner in Bay Minette, Baldwin County, Alabama. That there is no legal guardian of the said minor.

THIRD:

That the said E. F. Stuart, Jr., owns property consisting of interests in real and personal property located in Baldwin County, Alabama, and is for his age, a person of mature judgment and of sober and industrious habits and that he is competent and capable in every way of handling his own affairs as if he were of age and that it will be to the best interest of said minor to be relieved of the disabilities of non-age.

WHEREFORE, the premises considered, your Petitioner prays that this Honorable Court will set a day for the hearing of this Peition and will direct the issuance of notice to the said E. F. Stuart, Jr. of the filing of this Petition and of the day set to hear and determine the same, and that upon the hearing of this Petition that the Court will decree that the said E. F. Stuart, Jr. be relieved unconditionally from the disabilities of non-age and that the said E. F. Stuart, Jr. be vested with the right to sell and convey real and personal property, to contract, to sue and be sued, and in general, to do and perform such acts which said minor could lawfully do if he were twenty-one years of age. And your Petitioner prays for such other, further and different relief as in the premises may be meet and proper.

FINAL DECREE:

This proceeding is submitted on the Petition of Amanda Lou Stuart for the removal of the disabilities of non-age of E. F. Stuart, Jr., her son, and upon the Affidavits of Charles R. Barron, Thomas E. Mitchell and S. F. Holmes, and upon consideration, the Court is satisfied that it would be to the best interest of said minor to be relieved of the disabilities of non-age.

It is therefore ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court that the Petition be granted and that E. F. Stuart, Jr. be, and he hereby is relieved of the disabilities of non-age, and is vested with the right to sue and be sued, to contract, to buy, to sell and convey real estate, and generally to do and perform all the acts which he could lawfully do if he were of the full age of twenty-one years.

It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that E. F. Stuart, Jr. file a certified copy of this decree in the Office of the Probate Judge of Baldwin County, Alabama, and a certified copy hereof in the office of the Probate Judge of each other County in this State in which he may hereafter reside, or in which he may do any business or make any contracts.

It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Amanda Lou Stuart pay the costs of this proceeding, for which execution may issue.
