It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Complainant and Defendant be, and the same are hereby, dissolved, and that the said Elizabeth Klug is forever divorced from the said Rolland Klug for and on account of Cruelty

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that neither party to this suit shall again marry except to each other until sixty days after the rendition of this decree, and that if appeal is taken within sixty days, neither party shall again marry except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.

It is further ordered that the Complainant and Respondent be, and they are hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon the payment of the cost of this suit.

It is further ordered that Elizabeth Klug the Complainant pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which execution may issue.

My name is Elizabeth Klug. I am a bona fide resident of Baldwin County, Alabama, and have been all my life. I am sixteen years of age.

The Respondent and I married at Lucedale, Mississippi, on February 16th, 1950, and we lived together until about three weeks ago, that is about December 6, 1950.

The Respondent is Twenty-one years of age and a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama.

The Respondent and I have no children and I am sure that we will not. We have no community property.

The Respondent since we married has on numerous occasions threatened and abused me and from his conduct I have every reasonable apprehension to believe that he will carry out his threats and do actual violence to my person which will necessarily endanger my life and health. I know that the conditions are such that the Respondent and I can never live together as husband and wife.

My name is Dorothy Schneider. I am the mother of the Complainant. My daughter was too young at the time she and the Respondent married. They have not been able to make a go of it. I have considered the matter and know that it is to the best interest of all that the Complainant and the Respondent be granted a divorce and permitted to go their respective ways. They have no children, and I am sure that there is no reason why they should not be given their freedom at this time.



Your Complainant Elizabeth Klug, respectfully represents unto your Honor and this Honorable Court as follows:

1.

That your Complainant is a bona fide resident of Baldwin County, Alabama, and sixteen years of age; the Respondent is a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama, and over twenty-one years of age.

2.

That your Complainant and the Respondent married at Lucedale, Mississippi, on February 16th, 1950, and lived together as husband and wife until on to-wit December 6, 1950.

3.

That on to-wit December 6, 1950, and on several occasions prior thereto the Respondent threatened and abused the Complainant and threatened to do actual violence to her person which would necessarily endanger her life and health. The conduct of the Respondent was such as to give the Complainant every reasonable apprehension to believe and she did actually believe that if she continued to live with him he would carry out his threats and do actual violence to her person, which would necessarily endanger her life and health.

WHEREFORE the premises considered, the Complainant prays that your Honor will by proper process, make the said Rolland Klug party Respondent to this cause of action, requiring him to plead, answer or demur to the same within the time and under the penalties prescribed by law and the practice of this Honorable Court.

Your Complainant further prays that your Honor will, upon a hearing, hereof enter an order and decree granting to her an absolute decree of divorce, forever barring the bonds of matrimony existing between her and the Respondent; that your Complainant prays for such other, further, different or general relief as she may be in equity and good conscience entitled to receive and as in duty bound she will every pray.
