TO HONORABLE TELFAIR J. MASHBURI, JR., JUDGE OF THE CIRCUIT COURT OF BALDWIN COUNTY, ALABAMA, IN EQUITY:

Your Complainant, Anna Archer, despectfully represents unto your Honorand this Honorable Court as follows:

That your Complainant and the Asspondent are both residents of Baldwin County, Alabama, and over twenty-one years of age.

That Your Complainant and the Elspondent married at Lucedale, Missipsippi, on May 7, 1949, and lived together at husband and wife in Baldwin County, Alabama, until January 5, 1950.

That on January 5, 1950, the Respondent voluntarily abandoned the bed and board of your complainant and has remained away voluntarily and continuously since that time.

That there was born to the marriage between your Complainant and the Respondent a child Timothy Thomas Archer, thirteen months old and who has all of his life been with your Complainant, who is a suitable, fit

and proper person to have the cars; oustody and control; that the dest pondent is an able bodied man fully capable of caring and providing for the said child; that TWENTY (\$20.00) IDLLARS per week is a reasonable amount to be paid by the Respondent to the Complainant toward the maintenance and support of the minor child, Timothy Thomas Archer.

WHEREFORE, the premises const ered, the Complainant prays that your Honor will by proper process make the said Thomas Archer, party Respondent to this cause of action, requiring himto plead, answer or demor to the same within the time and under the penalties prescribed by law and the practice of this Honorable Court.

Complainant further prays that upon a hearing hereof, your Honor will enter an order and decree gratting to her an absolute decree of divorce, forever barring the bonds of matrimony existing between her and the Respondent; that she be granted such other, further, different or general relief as she may be in equity and good conscience entitled to receive.
