This cause coming on to be heard was submitted upon Bill of Complaint, Decree Pro Confessor on Answer and waiver and Testimony as noted by the Register, and upon consideration thereof, the Court is of the opinion that the Complainant is entitled to the relief prayed for in said bill.

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Complainant and Defendant be, and the same are hereby, dissolved, and that the said Mary Lourae Henry is forever divorced from the said Robert L. Henry for and on account of Cruelty

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that neither party to this suit shall again marry except to each other until sixty days after the rendition of this decree, and that if appeal is taken within sixty days, neither party shall again marry except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.

It is further ordered that the Complainant and Respondent be, and they are hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon the payment of the cost of this suit.

It is further ordered that Mary Lourae Henry the Complainant pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which execution may issue.

truth, the whole truth, and nothing but the truth, the said Mary Lourae Henry and
Mrs. Martha Speight doth depose and say as follows:

My name is Mary Lourae Henry. I am a resident of Foley, Baldwin County, Alabama, and over twenty-one years of age. The Respondent, Robert L. Henry is over twenty-one years of age, a resident of the State of Alabama, living in Montgomery at the present time.

The Respondent and I married in Montgomery, on April 13, 1950, and we lived together as husband and wife until on to-wit, July 20, 1951.

The Respondent and I have no children and no community property.

The Respondent soon after our marriage began mistreating, abusing and threatening me and often threatened to do violence to my person which would necessarily endanger my life and health. This condition grew worse from time to time until to-wit, July 20, 1951. I found that it was impossible for us to any longer live together as husband and wife, and I was, by the conduct of the Respondent toward me, forced to abandoned living with him.

Mary Lourae Henry

Mrs. Martha Speight, a witness for the Complainant being first duly sworn, deposes and says: I live at Foley, in Baldwin County, Alabama. The Complainant is my sister and is now and has for some time been living in the home with me. I remember when she and the Respondent married in Montgomery, Alabama, in April 1950. They lived together until about the middle of July 1951, when from the conduct of the Respondent my sister was forced to abandon living with him. My sister, the Complainant, has a home in Foley with me, and where she will make her permanent home.

The Complainant and the Respondent have no children. I know of my own personal knowledge and from my own personal observation that the Complainant can never live with the Respondent as his wife. This last time is the second time that she has had to leave her home on account of the treatment of the Respondent toward her.

Your Complainant, Mary Lourae Henry, respectfully represents unto your Honor and this Honorable Court as follows:

1.

That the Complainant and the Respondent are both over twenty-one years of age and bona fide residents of State of Alabama; that the Complainant is a resident of Foley, in Baldwin County, Alabama, and the Respondent is at present staying in Montgomery County, Alabama.

2.


That your Complainant and the Respondent married in Montgomery, Alabama, on April 13, 1950, and lived together as husband and wife until July 20, 1951.

3.

That on, to-wit, July 20, 1951, and on various occasion prior thereto the Respondent threatened and abused the Complainant and often threatened to do violence to her person which would necessarily endanger her life and health; that the conduct of the Respondent was such as to give the Complainant every reasonable apprehension to believe and she did actually believe that if she continued to live with him he would do actual violence to her person which would necessarily endanger her life and health.

WHEREFORE, the premises considered, the Complainant prays that your Honor will by proper process make the said Robert E. Henry party respondent to this cause of action, requiring him to plead, answer or demur to the same within the time and under the penalties prescribed by law and the practice of this Honorable Court.

Your Complainant prays that upon a hearing hereof, your Honor will enter an order and decree granting to her an absolute decree of divorce, forever barring the bonds of matrimony existing between her and the Respondent; Complainant prays for such other, further, different or general relief as he may be in equity and good conscience entitled to receive.

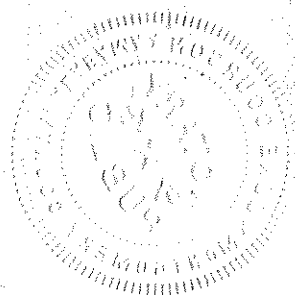
