My name is Willie W. Corley. I am the Complainant in this cause. Both the Respondent, Horace W. Corley, and I are over twenty-one years of age and bona fide residents of Baldwin County, Alabama, and have been all of our lives.

The Respondent and I married in Bay Minette, Alabama, on February 15, 1939. We lived together as husband and wife in Bay Minette, Baldwin County, Alabama, until on to-wit, December 20, 1951,

The Respondent oh, to-wit, December 20, 1951, and on various occasions prior thereto has threatened and abused me and threatened to do violence to my person which will necessarily endanger my life and health. The conduct of the respondent is such as to give me every reasonable apprehension to believe and I do actually believe that if I continue to live with him he will carry out his threats and do actual violence to my person which will necessarily endanger my life and health. The relationship between the Respondent and me has grown to the point where it is absolutely impossible for us to longer live together as husband and wife.

The Respondent and I have one child, Horace Donald Corley, age 8. He has been with me all of his life and I am the suitable, fit and proper person to have his care, custody and control. I am willing and do assume all responsibility of caring and providing for said child.

I know and have known for many years the Complainant and the Respondent in this cause. I have had occasion to be with and around them from time to time during the past years. I know that the conditions existing in their home are such as to render it impossible for the Complainant and the Respondent to live together as husband and wife. 3.




