 ried on or about, to-wit, July 12, 1947.


3. Complainant further avers that said respondent voluntarily

your complainant be mistaken in the relief prayed for, that there be granted to her such other, different and general relief to which she may be entitled and, as in duty bound, she will ever pray.



They were married in 1947, and in June of 1948 he left her with no cause. He has not provided a home for her since that time, nor have they lived together as man and wife.
