It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Complainant and Defendant be, and the same are hereby, dissolved, and that the said CLAYTON A. It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that neither party to this suit shall again marry except to each other until sixty days after the rendition of this decree, and that if appeal is taken within sixty days, neither party shall again marry except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.

It is further ordered that the Complainant and Respondent be, and they are hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon the payment of the cost of this suit.

It is further ordered that CLAYTON A. BUZBEE the Complainant, pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which execution may issue.

COUNTY, ALABAMA, IN EQUITY:

Your Complainant, CLAYTON A. BUZBEE, a bona fide resident citizen of Baldwin County, Alabama, over the age of twenty-one years, respectfully shows unto your Honor, that on or about September, 1946, Complainant intermarried with said BIRDIE CORINE BUZBEE at Milton, Florida, and they lived together as man and wife until about five (5) years ago at Pensacola, Florida, most of the time residing in Escambia County, Florida, and Complainant has been a bona fide resident citizen of Alabama for more than one year next preceding the filing of this bill.

2. Complainant further avers that said respondent voluntarily abandoned the bed and board of complainant for more than one year next preceding the filing of this bill of complaint, since which time complainant and respondent have not lived together nor in any way recognized each other as husband and wife.

WHEREFORE, the premises considered your Complainant prays that your Honor will by proper process make the said BIRDIE CORINE BUZBEE party respondent to this cause of action, requiring her to plead, answer or demur to the same within the time and under the penalties prescribed by law and the practice of this Honorable Court;

Complainant further prays that upon a final hearing hereof, your Honor will grant unto him an absolute decree of divorce forever barring the bonds of matrimony existing between him and the respondent; that your Honor will give and grant unto him such other, further, different or general relief as he may be entitled to receive, and as in duty bound he will ever pray.
