It is further ordered that Georgia Mae Jones Brown the Complainant pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which execution may issue.

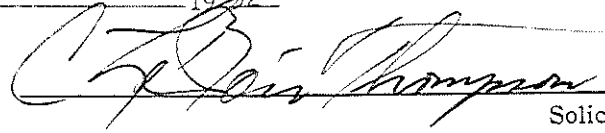

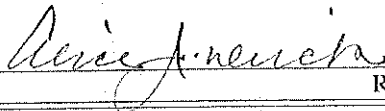

1.

That your Complainant is a bona fide resident of Baldwin County, Alabama, and is seventeen years of age; that the Respondent is a bona fide resident of Baldwin County, Alabama, and over eighteen years of age.

2.

That your Complainant and the Respondent married at Lucedale, Mississippi, on November 8, 1951, and lived together as husband and wife until January 12, 1952.

3.

That on to-wit January 12, 1952, and on several occasions prior thereto the Respondent threatened and abused the Complainant and threatened to do actual violence to her persons which would necessarily endanger her life and health. The conduct of the Respondent was such as to give the Complainant every reasonable apprehension to believe and

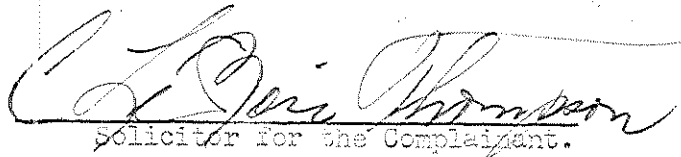
she did actually believe that if she continued to live with his he would carry out his threats and do actual violence to her person, which would necessarily endanger her life and health.

That your Complainant and the Respondent have no children as fruits of this marriage, and there is no property to be divided.

WHEREFORE, the premises considered, the Complainant prays that your Honor will by proper process make the said Louis F. Brown party Respondent to this cause of action, requiring him to plead, answer or demur to the same within the time and under the penalties prescribed by law and the practice of this Honorable Court.

Your Complainant prays that upon a hearing hereof, Your Honor will enter an order and decree granting to her an absolute decree of divorce, forever barring the bonds of matrimony existing between her and the Respondent; Complainant prays for such other, further, different or general relief as she may be in equity and good conscience entitled to receive.

in Bay Minette, Alabama, and having first sworn said Witness es to speak the truth, the whole truth, and nothing but the truth, the said Georgia Mae Jones Brown and Georgia Jones doth depose and say as follows:

That my name is Georgia Mae Jones Brown, that I am over the age of 17 years, and bona fide resident of Baldwin County, Alabama, and have been more than two years next preceding; that the Respondent, Louis F. Brown, is over the age of 18 years, and was a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama, at the time of our separation; we were married at Lucedale, Mississippi, on November 8, 1951, and lived together as husband and wife until January 12, 1952, at which time I was forced to leave him because I was in fear of my life and health. We had been married about five weeks when he jumped on me and beat me, striking me in the face and about the body, after I had forgiven him for this he would from time to time lose his temper and jump on me again without cause on my part until finally on the day of our separation he threatened me so and when he jumped on me and struck me I knew I could never live with him anymore, I carried bruises caused by his blows for some time afterward; there were no children as fruits of our marriage and no property to be divided. I respectfully ask the court for the right to resume my maiden name, Georgia Mae Jones.

Georgia Mae Jones Brown

That my name is Georgia Jones I am the mother of the Complainant and I know both parties to this cause. Georgia Mae is over the age of 17 years, and has been a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama all her life; Louis F. Brown is over the age of 18 years, and was a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama at the time of their separation they went over to Lucedale, Mississippi and got married on November 8, 1951 and lived together as husband and wife until January 12, 1952, during this time Louis would fly into a rage without fault on Georgia Mae's part and hit her with his fist about the face and body until she became afraid for her life and health and the separation occurred January 12, 1952. There were no children and no property to be divided I do not believe that they can ever live together as husband and wife again.

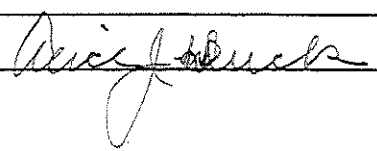
