This cause coming on to be heard was submitted upon Bill of Complaint, Decree Pro Confesso on ~~Answer and Waiver~~ and Testimony as noted by the Register, and upon consideration thereof, the Court is of the opinion that the Complainant is entitled to the relief prayed for in said bill.

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Complainant and Defendant be, and the same are hereby, dissolved, and that the said Dovie Hadley is forever divorced from the said William Lee Hadley for and on account of living separate and apart from the bed and board of respondent for two years and without support from him for two years.

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that neither party to this suit shall again marry except to each other until sixty days after the rendition of this decree, and that if appeal is taken within sixty days, neither party shall again marry except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.

It is further ordered that the Complainant and the Respondent be, and they are hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon the payment of the cost of this suit.

It is further ordered that Dovie Hadley the Complainant pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which execution may issue.


2. That your Complainant and Respondent were lawfully married on or about, to-wit, December 9, 1943, at Bay Minette, Alabama.

The premises considered, your Complainant makes the said William Lee Hadley a party respondent to this Bill of Complaint, and in order that Complainant may have the relief herein prayed for, may it please your Honor to cause the State's writ of subpoena to be issued, directed, to the said William Lee Hadley commanding him to answer, plead or demur

to this Bill of Complaint, within the time required by law;
and that on a final hearing of this cause, that your Honor
will enter a decree divorcing your Complainant from said
Respondent, granting the Complainant the right to remarry
and granting the Complainant the right to resume her maiden
name; and that your Honor will grant such other, further,
and different relief as unto your Honor may seem just and
proper.

Me and William Lee did not have any children.

I have knowed Dovie many years, she is over twenty-one and has been living here in Baldwin County for way younder more than five years. She married William Lee Hadley sometime in December back in 1943 up in Bay Minette. Willaim Lee is over twenty-one and lives in this place down in Florida called Raiford. She has lived separate and away from William Lee for two years or more and during these last two years or more William Lee ain't supported her even one pennys worth, she has lived without any support from him at all for more than the last two years, and during all this time she has been living right here in Alabama. They never had any children.

I have knew Dovie all her life, she is over twenty-one years old and has lived right here in Baldwin County allher life.
