It is further ordered that the Complainant and Respondent be, and they are hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon the payment of the cost of this suit.

It is further ordered that Inez V. Griffin the Complainant pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which execution may issue.




That your Complainant and the Respondent were married at Jackson County, Alabama, August 10, 1917, and lived together as husband and wife until on to-wit, January 5, 1951.


