To the Honorable Telfair J. Mashburn, Jr., Judge of said Court, sitting in Equity,

Comes Mary Lou Odom and exhibits this, her bill of complaint against William L. Odom and shows unto Your Honor as follows:

- 1. Complainant, whose age is 20 years, and Respondent, whose age is 21 years, intermarried on May 20th 1950 at Ludedale, Mississippi.
- 3. Prior to their marriage and ever since, both parties have been residents of Baldwin County, Alabama
- 4. Until they separated as a result of the acts hereinafter complained of, on numerous occasions, Respondent committed acts of physical violence upon the person of Complainant so as to put her in fear of her life, health and limbs and, from his conduct, there is reasonable apprehension that he might continue such acts.
- 5. During the month of February, 1952, as a result of the acts complained of, Complainant ceased living with Respondent and they have lived separate and apart ever since.

The premises considered, Complainant prays that said William L. Odom be, by all due and appropriate process, made party defendant to this suit, that he be compelled to plead, answer or demur to the several paragraphs hereof within the time prescribed by law and that he be compelled to obey and abide all orders and decrees made in the premises.

Further, Complainant prays, upon a hearing of the within cause, that she be granted an absolute divorce from said William L. Odom and such other, further and different relief as may, in Equity, seem meet and proper.
