TO THE HONORABLE F. W. HARE, JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

Your petitioner, Frank Vidas, respectfully represents unto your Honor that he is a resident of this County and State and is over the age of twenty-one years. Petitioner further represents unto the Court that he is the father of Mary Vidas, a minor over the age of eighteen years who resides with your petitioner. The mother of said minor is dead. The said Mary Vidas has no general guardian and is entitled to certain real and personal property in her own right and it would be to her interest to have her disabilities of non-age removed. The said Mary Vidas is sober and industrious, possessed of sound judgment and as fully capable of handling her own affairs as if she were of full age.

WHEREFORE, petitioner prays that the said Mary Vidas may be given notice as required by law of this petition, that your Honor and the Court will relieve her of her disability of non-age, and that she be vested with the power to sue and be sued, contract and be contracted with and to take possession of and sell and convey real and personal property as if she were 21 years of age.

This cause coming on to be heard in term time and having been submitted for decree on the verified petition filed in said cause and ex parte affidavits of E.C. Weekley and J.A. Havard, thereupon, upon consideration thereof, it is ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that Mary Vidas, who is a minor over the age of eighteen years, be, and she is, relieved of the disabilities of non-age, and she is vested with the power to sue and be sued, contract and be contracted with, to receive and take possession of any real and personal property to which she is entitled, to purchase real or personal property, to sell and to convey, and to do all things, and to all intents and purposes, as effectually as if she were twenty-one years of age.

It is further decreed that the said Frank Vidas pay the costs of this proceeding, for which execution may issue.
