have called and caused to come before me Lois Arnette Morgan and Thaggard Powell

witnesses named in the Requirement for Oral Examination, on the 18 day of April 1952, at the office of C. LeNoir Thompson in Bay Minette, Alabama, and having first sworn said Witnesses to speak the truth, the whole truth, and nothing but the truth, the said Lois Arnette Morgan and Thaggard Powell doth depose and say as follows:

That my name is Lois Arnette Morgan, I am over the age of 21, and have been a resident of Alabama since birth, the Respondent, John H. Morgan is also over the age of 21, and has been a resident of Alabama more than two years the next preceding. We were married July 5, 1951 at Pascagoula, Mississippi, and lived together until September 15, 1951, as husband and wife, at which time the separation occurred, we have no children as fruits of this marriage, and no property to be divided. Shortly after the wedding the respondent made demand upon me to turn all my property over to him by gift or deed, and upon being refused his demand became so strange that I feared my life and health, if I did deed the property to him, and I was afraid of what would happen if I did not deed the property to him. The reason that I was afraid was that he locked me in the room after I refused to deed my property to him, and struck me first with his fist and then took a walking cane and threatened to whip me if I did not deed the property to him, when I got out of the room I left because I knew what he would do to me.

That my name is Thaggard Powell, I know both parties to this cause, that they are over the age of 21, and are residents of Alabama, they were married in Pascagoula, Mississippi, July 5, 1951, and lived together as husband and wife until September 15, 1951, at which time they separated because of the separation being the unreasonable attitude on the part of John H. Morgan, who shortly after the wedding demanded that his wife deed all her property to him, and when she refused continued to make demand, and talk about her dying suddenly if she did not do this. I know that she became afraid of him, and as she put it, was afraid to deed him the property and live with him for fear that she would dy suddenly, and afraid not to deed him the property and live with him for fear something would happen to her I know she could never live with him again because of the statements she made and the way he made them about her dying suddenly, they have no children as fruits of this marriage and there was no property to be divided between them.






Now comes the Respondent and accepts service of the summons and complaint in this cause.

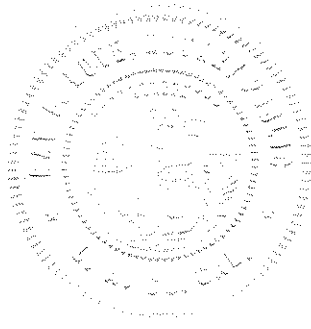
The Respondent admits the allegations as to ages, marriage and residence, but denies all other allegations contained in the bill of Complaint, and demand strict proof of the same.
