right to remarry.

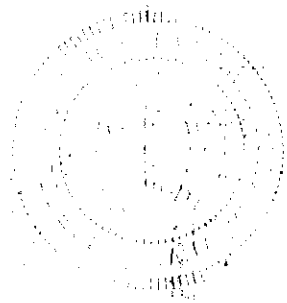
