And it appearing to the Court that the said Victoria Lazzari is a minor over the age of eighteen years; that both she and the petitioner are residents of the County of Baldwin and State of Alabama; that petitioner is the father of said child and that her mother is dead and that she has no legal guardian; and it further appearing to the Court that it will be to the best interests of said minor to be relieved of the disabilities of non-age:

It is therefore ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED by the Court that Victoria Lazzari be, and she is hereby, relieved of the disabilities of non-age and invested with the right to sue and be sued, contract, buy, sell and convey real estate, and generally to do and perform all acts and deeds which she could lawfully do if she were twenty-one years of age.

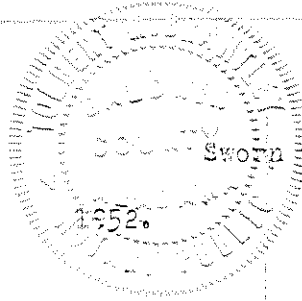

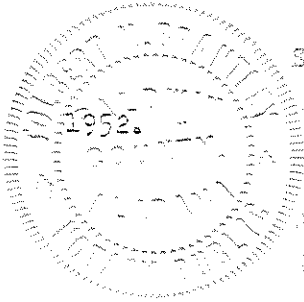

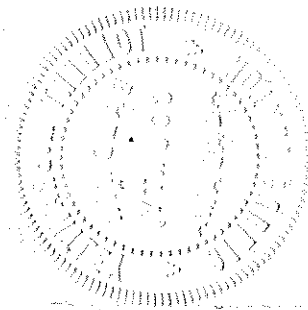
