

Comes the Complainant, the State of Alabama, on the relation of Kenneth Cooper, as Circuit Solicitor of the 28th Judicial Circuit, Baldwin County, Alabama, who relates and give the Court to understand and be informed of the following facts:

(1) That Kenneth Cooper, as Circuit Solicitor of the 28th Judicial Circuit, Baldwin County, Alabama, is authorized to bring this bill of complaint for condemnation proceedings of the property hereinafter described;

(2) That Mary C. Harden, in whose possession the following property hereinafter described was found, is over the age of twenty-one years, and is a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama;

(3) That Mary C. Harden on, to-wit, June 14, 1957, did, as a liquor licensee of the State of Alabama, have in her possession or under her control as owner and operator of the Canal Hotel, at Gulf Shores, located in Baldwin County, Alabama, fifty-one (51) pint size and eleven (11) fifth size assorted brands of liquors, and twenty-nine (29) assorted pint and fifth size s of assorted brands of liquors, described as follows, from which said bottles or portions of a part of said bolttles of liquors she, or those working in her employment or under her direction and/or control, did sell to customers, patrons, or guests of the Canal Hotel, also known as the Canal Cafe and Cottages:


