AGREEMENT OF PARTIES CONTEMPLATING A DIVORCE WITH REFERENCE TO CUSTODY OF CHILDREN AND PROPERTY RIGHTS

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration thereof, and of mutual agreements hereinafter made, they have mutually agreed to a complete separation under the following expressed terms and conditions.

- 1. The said parties shall entirely and completely separate as man and wife, living separate and apart, and neither party hereafter shall in any way harass, threaten, intimidate or otherwise act in anyway so as to embarrass or humilate the other party.
- 2. The Party of the First Part shall have the custody, control and care of the children, Carol Jean Sisson and Patricia Marie Sisson. It is understood and agreed, however, that the Party of the Second Part shall have the right to have the children two months of the year, the right to be exercised to coincide with the Party of the Second Part's leave from the Service each year.
- 3. The Party of the Second Part agrees to pay the Party of the First Part for the support and maintenances of the aforesaid children the sum of SEVENTY-FIVE (\$75.00) DOLLARS a month.

- 4. The Party of the Second Part agrees that the Party of the First Part shall have all the furniture and fixtures that the Parties now own jointly.
- 5. The Party of the First Part agrees that the Party of the Second Part shall have the Automobile now owned jointly by the Parties.


