It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that the Complainant, be awarded the care custody and control of the Minor children, Carol Jean Sisson and Patricia Marie Sisson, with the right of the Respondent to have the said children visit him for two months out of each year.

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that the Respondent pay to the Complainant for the care, support and maintenance of said children the sum of SEVENTY-FIVE and no/100 DOLLARS (\$75.00) Per Month.

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that neither party to this suit shall again marry except to each other until sixty days after the rendition of this decree, and that if appeal is taken within sixty days, neither party shall again marry except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.

It is further ordered that the Complainant and Respondent be, and they are hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon payment of the cost of this suit.

It is further ordered that JIM CHARLES SISSON the RESPONDENT pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which executed may issue.

AGREEMENT OF PARTIES CONTEMPLATING A
DIVORCE WITH REFERENCE TO CUSTODY OF

This agreement made and entered into on this the 6th
day of AUGUST, 1957, by and between Vivian Violet Sisson,
hereinafter referred to as the Party of the First Part, and

Second Part: WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the parties hereto have been husband and wife for

WHEREAS, said parties have definitely concluded that under
conditions now existing it is impractical for them to live to-
gether as man and wife.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration thereof, and of mutual agree-
ments hereinafter made, they have mutually agreed to a complete
separation under the following expressed terms and conditions.

1. The said parties shall entirely and completely separate as
man and wife, living separate and apart, and neither party here-
after shall in any way harass, threaten, intimidate or otherwise
act in anyway so as to embarrass or humilate the other party.
2. The Party of the First Part shall have the custody, control
and care of the children, Carol Jean Sisson and Patricia Marie
Sisson. It is understood and agreed, however, that the Party of
the Second Part shall have the right to have the children two
months of the year, the right to be exercised to coincide with
the Party of the Second Part's leave from the Service each year.

their mother, the Complainant; that your Complainant is a suitable
