It is further ordered that LULA STALLMORTH the Complainant pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which executed may issue.





And now comes your complainant, Lula Stallworth, and humbly complaining against Robert Lee Stallworth, defendant, respectfully shows unto your Honor:

First: That your complainant and the said Robert Lee Stallworth are each over the age of twenty-one years; that your complainant is a resident of Baldwin County, where she has resided all of her life; that the defendant is a resident of Mobile, Alabama, 1056 St. Meter Street, where he has resided for more than twelve months next preceeding the filing of this bill of complaint.

Second: That your complainant and the said Robert Lee Stallworth are husband and wife having intermarried at Tensaw, Alabama, July 7, 1952, and they lived together as husband and wife at Tensaw, Alabama until December, 1955, when the said Robert Lee Stallworth

voluntarily abandoned this complainant without just cause and reasonable excuse; that the said Robert Lee Stallworth and this complainant have not lived together for more than twelve months next preceeding the filing of this bill of complaint;

WHEREFORE your complainant prays that this Honorable Court will take jurisdiction of the cause made by this bill of complaint and make the said Robert Lee Stallworth party defendant hereto and by appropriate process require him to plead, answer or demur to the same within the time and under the pains and penalties prescribed by law and the practice of this Honorable Court.

Complainant further prays that upon the final hearing of this cause this Honorable Court will make and enter a decree forever dissolving the bonds of matrimony existing between this complainant and the said defendant and complainant prays for such other, further or different relief as in equity and good conscience she shall be entitled to receive in the premises.
