Dear Madam;

In response to your letter of October 31, 1967 which was forwarded to this office for attention, we cited Mr. Paul to appear to show cause why he should not be charged with contempt of court.

Mr. Paul did in fact show cause by virtue of injury sustained in July and a stroke suffered in October.

Further; Mr. Paul contended in our first interview that the eldest and youngest children alleged in your reciprocal order could not possibly be his by virtue of physical separation. He was invited to prove these statements by documentation.

Mr. Paul was re-interviewed this date at which time he produced his army discharge and service record which corroborate his statement that he was in Japan for eleven months prior to the birth of Brenda Kay Paul, the eldest child alleged to be his by Barbara Nell Paul. Mr. Paul also produced employment records and a complaint of divorce from Inglewood, California which corroborate his statement that he was in California for eleven months prior to the birth of Myrna Nell Paul, the youngest child alleged to be his by Barbara Nell Paul.

On the basis of Robert A. Paul's sworn testimony, corroborated by the within described documentation we plan to seek modification of the now existing order of support in our case No. 90884 on the December calendar of the Indio Superior Court in Blythe.

Mr. Paul will continue support of Charlotte Ann Paul in an amount which is commensurate with his reduced earning capacity, to-wit: \$40.00 per month.



May we suggest that when you do secure a new position, you endeavor at that time to make the regular payments of \$15.00 a week and add as much as possible to this to take care of any payments that you are forced to miss.


