IT IS FURTHER ORDERED ADJUDGED AND DECREED That the Respondent James C. Cope-
land pay to the Complainant, Betty Jean Copeland, the sum of TWENTY DOLLARS
(\$20.00) Per week for the support of the said minor children.

It is futher ordered, adjudged and decreed that neither party to this suit shall again marry except
to each other until sixty days after the rendition of this decree, and that if appeal is taken within sixty
days, neither party shall again marry except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.

It is futher ordered that the Complainant and Respondent be, and they are hereby permitted to
again contract marriage upon payment of the cost of this suit.

It is futher ordered that ----- James C. Copeland -----
the Respondent ----- pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which executed may issue.

ren, Winnie Ellen Copeland and James C. Copeland, Jr., who are now
living with the Complainant in this cause; that the Complainant is
a fit and proper person to have the care, custody, and control of
the said minor children; That the Respondent is an able bodied man
and is well able to support the said minor children.

PRAYER FOR PROCESS AND RELIEF

WHEREFORE, THE PREMISES CONSIDERED, Your Complainant prays that your Honor will by proper process make the said James C. Copeland, party Respondent to this Bill of Complaint requiring him to plead, answer or demur to the same within the time and under the penalties prescribed by law and the practice of this Honorable Court.

Your Complainant further prays that upon a final hearing hereof your Honor will enter a decree forever barring the bonds of matrimony now existing between the Complainant and the Respondent; that the Complainant be awarded the care, custody and control of the heretofore mentioned minor children; That the Respondent be required to pay a suitable amount as support for the minor children; and that your Complainant be allowed the right to remarry should she so desire.



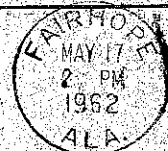

PETITION TO MODIFY CUSTODY

TO THE HONORABLE HUBERT M. HALL, JUDGE OF THE CIRCUIT COURT OF BALDWIN COUNTY, ALABAMA, IN EQUITY SITTING:

Comes now the Respondent, James C. Copeland, in the above styled cause, respectfully shows unto your Honor in this Honorable Court as follows:

ONE: That your Respondent is a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama, and over the age of twenty-one years; that the complainant is a non-resident of the State of Alabama, and whose address is 8141 Shore Drive, Lot 576, Norfolk 3, Virginia, and who is over the age of twenty-one years.

TWO: That your Respondent and the Complainant were permanently divorced from the bonds of matrimony by decree granted by the Circuit Court of Baldwin County, Alabama, on the 23rd day of January, 1958; and that under the said divorce decree the Complainant was awarded the permanent care, custody and control of the two minor children, Winnie Ellen Copeland, and James C. Copeland Jr.

THREE: That subsequent to the time of issuing of the said final decree of divorce in this cause, the complainant Betty Jean Copeland has married and that her married name is now Betty Jean Copeland Bramlett; and that subsequent to the time of the final decree of divorce being granted, this Honorable Court, the Complainant has removed the said children from the State of Alabama, but that the respondent now has possession of the said children.

FOUR: That the Complainant, Betty Jean Copeland Bramlett, has become addicted to the habitual use of alcohol, and is not a fit and proper person to have the care, custody and control of the heretofore mentioned minor children; in that she leaves the said minor children for long periods of time unattended, she beats them unmercifully, that they are not properly fed, clothed, nor do they have proper medical attention.

FIVE: Your Respondent further alleges that he verily believes that the Complainant, Betty Jean Copeland Bramlett, also uses narcotics and that the said children are in constant fear when in the possession of the Complainant.

PRAYER FOR RELIEF






Your petitioner further prays that upon a hearing hereof, your honor will enter an order or decree allowing the two minor children to remain in the respondent's home during both the summer and winter months.
