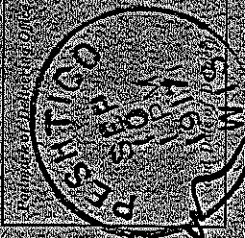

ORATOR CHARGES:-

FIRST:-----That he and the respondent Louisa Anderson Olsen were married at Marinette in the State of Wisconsin in the year 1891 and consorted together as man and wife until January 3d, 1912.

SECOND:-----That while residing together as man and wife near Gateswood in Baldwin County, Alabama, the said Louisa Anderson Olsen on to-wit, January 3d, 1912, voluntarily deserted and abandoned your Orator without just cause, and has continuously deserted and abandoned your Orator without just cause and has refused often to return and live with him as man and wife.

The premises considered, Orator prays that your Honor will make and cause to be issued such orders and decrees and subpoenas as will be necessary to make the said Louisa Anderson Olsen party respondent to this bill of complaint for divorce.
