This cause coming on to be heard was submitted upon Bill of Complaint, Decree Pro Confesso on Answer and Waiver and Testimony as noted by the Register, and upon consideration thereof, the Court is of the opinion that the Complainant is entitled to the relief prayed for in said bill.

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Complainant and Defendant be, and the same are hereby dissolved, and that the said Dorothy Pauline Robinson is forever divorced from the said Dudley Robinson for and on account of Cruelty. It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that the care, custody and control of the minor child, Wallace Eugene Robinson, of the parties.

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that the stipulated agreement entered into between the parties as to distribution of property and obligations of the parties is hereby confirmed and ratified.

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that neither party to this suit shall again marry except to each other until sixty days after the rendition of this decree, and that if appeal is taken within sixty days, neither party shall again marry except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.

It is further ordered that the Complainant and Respondent be, and they are hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon payment of the cost of this suit.

It is further ordered that Complainant, Dorothy Pauline Robinson, the Complainant pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which executed may issue.



3. Respondent admits the allegations of the third paragraph of the Bill of Complaint.

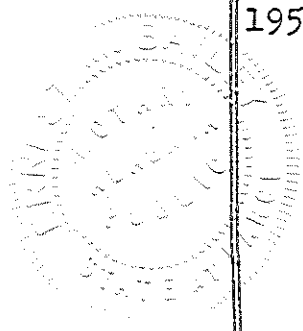

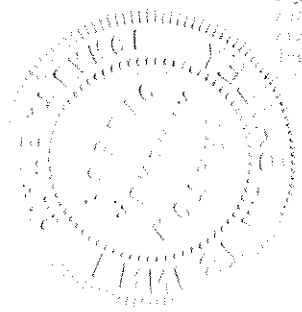

Comes your Complainant, Dorothy Pauline Robinson, and files this her Bill of Complaint for divorce against Dudley Robinson, and shows unto this Honorable Court and to Your Honor as follows:

FIRST:

That your Complainant and the Respondent are over the age of twenty-one years and are bona fide residents of Fairhope, Baldwin County, Alabama for more than one year preceding the filing of this Bill of Complaint.

SECOND:

That your Complainant and the Respondent were married on, heretofore, to-wit, January 10, 1948 in Indianapolis, Indiana and lived together as man and wife until on, to-wit, September 19th, 1957, when, on account of the matters hereinafter complained of, your Complainant was forced to live separate and apart from the Res-

pondent; that on September 19, 1957 and at times prior thereto, the Complainant states that the Respondent, from his manner and conduct towards her, gave reasonable apprehension of committing violence on her person and that from his manner and conduct towards her, she is reasonably certain that he will commit violence upon her person, attended with danger to her life and health.

THIRD:

That there was born of this marriage between the Complainant and the Respondent one child, Wallace Eugene Robinson, aged nine years of age. That the Complainant is a fit and proper person to have the care, custody and control of the said minor child. That your Complainant and the Respondent have heretofore entered into an agreement disposing of their real and personal property, a copy of which agreement is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

PRAYER FOR PROCESS AND RELIEF:

The premises considered, your Complainant prays that the above named Dudley Robinson be made a party defendant to this cause by the usual writ or process of this Honorable Court requiring him to appear and plead, answer or demur within the time and under the penalties prescribed by the rules of this Court and the Statutes in such cases made and provided; that upon a final hearing of this cause Your Honor will award your Complainant the care, custody and control of her minor child; that Your Honor will grant unto your Complainant an absolute divorce and will decree that the parties be allowed to remarry if they see fit; and that Your Honor will ratify and confirm the agreement between the parties disposing of their property. Should your Complainant be mistaken in the relief prayed for, that there be granted to her such other, further and different relief to which she may be entitled and as in duty bound she will ever pray.

STIPULATED AGREEMENT

This Stipulated Agreement made and entered into by and between Dorothy Pauline Robinson and Dudley Robinson this the 21st day of September, 1957, Witnesseth:

That Whereas the parties hereto have been husband and wife and as a result of such union have one child, Wallace Eugene Robinson, aged nine years of age; and whereas the parties have definitely concluded that under conditions now existing, it is impossible for them to continue to live together as man and wife;

Now, therefore, in consideration thereof and of the mutual agreements heretofore agreed, they have mutually agreed to a complete separation under the following terms and conditions:

1. The parties shall entirely and completely separate as man and wife, live separately and apart, and neither party hereafter shall in any way harrass, threaten, intimidate or otherwise act in any way so as to embarrass or humiliate the other party.

2. That the said Dorothy Pauline Robinson shall have the care, custody and control of the child of their marriage, Wallace Eugene Robinson, with the right of the father to visit him at reasonable and proper times.

3. That the parties are possessed of jointly held real and personal property consisting of real estate heretofore occupied as a home site, located at 53 South School Street in the city of Fairhope, Baldwin County, Alabama and household furnishings located therein; that the parties shall sell or otherwise dispose of the property and the net proceeds shall be divided equally between the parties, provided, however, that the parties have incurred certain obligations of indebtedness which have been approximately equally distributed between the parties, which division has been noted by separate instrument; and the parties desiring to satisfy these obligations, it is understood and agreed that each party shall satisfy and discharge that portion of the indebtedness so allocated to them individually without obligation to the other party.

4. Each party hereto shall be entitled to his or her personal effects.

It is further agreed by and between the parties that this Stipulated Agreement may be used by either party whom shall file for proceedings of divorce and the parties agree that the agreement and all of its terms may be submitted to the Court for its approval and confirmation and may become a part of any decree rendered by said Court having jurisdiction over the same.
