days, neither party shall again marry except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.

It is further ordered that the Complainant and Respondent be, and they are hereby permitted to
again contract marriage upon payment of the cost of this suit.

It is further ordered that Rex James Mangum
the Complainant pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which executed may issue.

AGREEMENT OF PARTIES CONTEMPLATING A DIVORCE WITH REFERENCE TO
CUSTODY OF CHILDREN, SUPPORT OF CHILDREN, AND PROPERTY RIGHTS

STATE OF ALABAMA)
BALDWIN COUNTY)

This agreement, made and entered into in triplicate, by
and between Rex James Mangum, hereinafter called husband, and
Eva Annette Wingate Mangum, hereinafter called wife, witnesseth:

That whereas, various and divers disputes and unhappy
differences have arisen between husband and wife, and they are
separated and not now living together as husband and wife, and
whereas it is the desire of the parties hereto to make a complete
and final settlement of all their property, and to settle and
adjust all marital interests, now, therefore, this agreement is
made as follows:

1. The wife shall have the care, custody, and control of
the minor children, George Edwin Mangum, Rex James Mangum, Jr.,
and Terry Ann Mangum. The husband shall have the right of visi-
tation at reasonable times and places.

2. The husband shall pay to the wife the following sums
for the support and maintenance for the minor children, until
the youngest of said children shall have attained the age of
twenty-one years: The sum of \$50.00 per month.

3. The husband further agrees and does hereby release and
transfer to the wife as her sole property, all furniture and
household furnishings owned by the parties, and the home owned
by said parties in Jacksonville, Florida.

4. It is further agreed that any and all property acquired
by either parties subsequent to the date of this agreement shall
be the separate property of said party acquiring same; and each
party agrees to execute for the other any and all papers necessary
to complete the transfer of property herewith divided and appor-
tioned. It is further agreed that the terms of this agreement
may be incorporated in any decree of divorce which may be here-
after obtained by either party, and enforced by contempt proceed-
ings if necessary.

5. It is agreed and understood by the parties that in con-
sideration of this agreement, no further alimony shall be due
or shall grow due between these parties.

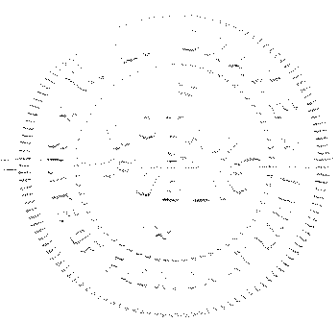

TO THE HONORABLE H.M. HALL, JUDGE OF THE CIRCUIT COURT OF
BALDWIN COUNTY, ALABAMA, SITTING IN EQUITY:

Comes your Complainant, Rex James Mangum, and respectfully shows
unto this Honorable Court as follows:

1. That he is over the age of twenty-one years and that he is a bona fide resident citizen of Baldwin County, Alabama, and has been such for more than one year next preceeding the filing of this Bill of Complaint; that Eva Annette Wingate Mangum, the Respondent in this cause, is over the age of twenty-one years and a resident citizen of Baldwin County, Alabama.

2. That on, to-wit, the 13th day of August, 1951, your Complainant and the Respondent were intermarried at Kingsland, County of Camden, State of Georgia, and that your Complainant and the Respondent are still husband and wife.

3. That there has been born of said marriage three minor children, whose names and ages are, respectively: George Edwin Mangum, age five; Rex James Mangum, Jr., age three; and Terry Ann Mangum, age one. That said minor children are in the custody of the Respondent.

4. That your Complainant and the Respondent have entered into an agreement with reference to a property settlement, and support and custody of the said minor children, which agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof as though fully set forth herein.

5. Your Complainant avers and charges that the Respondent, Eva Annette Wingate Mangum, separated from and abandoned your Complainant on, to-wit, the 4th day of December, 1956, without cause or justification, and that your Complainant & the Respondent since that date have been and are now living separate and apart.

THE PREMISES CONSIDERED, your Complainant prays that the Respondent be made a party Respondent to this Bill of Complaint by the usual process of this Honorable Court, and the statutes in such cases made and provided, requiring her to plead, answer, or demur within the time and within the manner required by law; and that upon a final hearing of this cause, that Your Honor will enter a decree divorcing the Complainant from the Respondent, granting to the Complainant the right to remarry, and granting and awarding the Respondent the care, custody and control of said minor children of the marriage, decreeing that the support agreement heretofore entered and made a part of this Bill of Complaint be declared a just and fair agreement, and decreeing that the parties hereto live and abide and obey the terms of the said agreement; Complainant further avers that the said agreement is a reasonable, just, and proper agreement; and Complainant further prays that Your Honor will grant such other, further, different and general relief to which the Complainant may be entitled, and as in duty bound he will ever pray.


